**AN ACT CONCERNING REDUCED TAX LIABILITY FOR THE HIRING
AND TRAINING OF CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to provide a deduction or
- 2 credit against tax liability in this state for employers who hire and train
- 3 individuals who are (1) ex-offenders, (2) noncustodial parents and
- 4 delinquent on court-ordered child support payments, or (3)
- 5 substantially unemployed.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce tax liability in this state for those who hire and train individuals who are either ex-offenders, delinquent on court-ordered noncustodial child support payments or substantially unemployed.
