AN ACT CONCERNING THE SERVICE OF INCOME WITHHOLDING ORDERS FOR CHILD SUPPORT OBLIGATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (h) of section 52-362 of the 2008 supplement to
2 the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
3 thereof (*Effective July 1, 2008*):

4 (h) Service of any process under this section, including any notice,
5 may be made in accordance with section 52-57, or by certified mail,
6 return receipt requested. If service is made on behalf of the state, it
7 may be made by an authorized employee of Support Enforcement
8 Services, [or] by an investigator or other officer of the Bureau of Child
9 Support Enforcement within the Department of Social Services, [or] by
10 an investigator of the Department of Administrative Services or by the
11 Attorney General. Service of income withholding orders by Support
12 Enforcement Services or by an investigator or other officer of said
13 bureau upon an employer under this section may be made in
14 accordance with section 52-57, by certified mail, return receipt
15 requested, or by first class mail, or electronically, provided the
16 employer agrees to accept service made electronically.

Statement of Purpose:

To authorize the service, by electronic means, of income withholding orders for child support obligations on an employer if the employer agrees to accept such form of service.
