AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF THE TOXICITY OF ARTIFICIAL TURF ATHLETIC FIELDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) On or before September 1, 2008, the
- 2 Department of Environmental Protection shall contract with a person,
- 3 firm, corporation or other entity to conduct a study of the toxicity of
- 4 artificial turf athletic fields. Said study shall evaluate whether such
- 5 fields cause harmful effects on air quality, water quality or human
- 6 health. Not later than February 1, 2008, said entity shall report in
- 7 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes
- 8 to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
- 9 cognizance of matters relating to the environment the conclusions of
- 10 said study.
- 11 Sec. 2. (*Effective July 1, 2008*) The sum of two hundred fifty thousand
- 12 dollars is appropriated to the Department of Environmental
- 13 Protection, from the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30,
- 14 2009, for the purposes of a grant to the entity selected by the
- 15 Commissioner of Environmental Protection to conduct the study
- 16 required by section 1 of this act.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	from passage	New section
Sec. 2	July 1, 2008	New section
