AN ACT CONCERNING LICENSE RENEWAL FEES FOR PHYSICIANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 20-10c of the 2008 supplement to the general
2 statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof
3 (*Effective October 1, 2008*):

4 Any person who practices medicine for no fee, for at least one
5 hundred hours per year at a public health facility, as defined in section
6 20-126l, or in connection with a mobile health clinic that provides
7 health care services to individuals of this state, and does not otherwise
8 engage in the practice of medicine, shall be eligible to renew a license,
9 as provided in subsection (b) of section 19a-88 of the 2008 supplement
10 to the general statutes, without payment of the professional services
11 fee specified in said subsection (b).

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	<i>October 1, 2008</i>	20-10c
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Statement of Purpose:

To encourage physicians to provide free medical care by allowing physicians who provide health care services in connection with a mobile health clinic to qualify for an exemption from payment of certain professional fees.
