**AN ACT CONCERNING THE DISCLOSURE OF MOTOR VEHICLE
CONVEYANCE FEES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 14-62a of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2008*):

3 (a) No dealer licensed under the provisions of section 14-52 shall
4 advertise the price of any motor vehicle unless the stated price in such
5 advertisement includes the federal tax, the cost of delivery, dealer
6 preparation, dealer conveyance fees and any other charges of any
7 nature, except that such advertisement shall state in at least eight-point
8 bold type that any state or local tax [,] or registration fees [or dealer
9 conveyance fee or processing fee, as defined in subsection (a) of section
10 14-62, is] are excluded from such stated price.

11 (b) Any new car dealer violating the provisions of this section shall
12 be fined not more than one thousand dollars. The Commissioner of
13 Motor Vehicles may suspend or revoke, in accordance with section 14-
14 64, the license of any such dealer violating the provisions of this
15 section.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	July 1, 2008	14-62a
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Statement of Purpose:

To require any advertised price for the sale of a motor vehicle to include dealer conveyance fees charged to the purchaser.
