AN ACT CONCERNING BEER COOLER ACCESSIBILITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) No regulation adopted
2 pursuant to the authority of chapter 545 of the general statutes shall
3 require that beer coolers accessible to the public be locked during
4 hours when the sale of alcoholic liquors for off-premises consumption
5 is forbidden and grocery store beer permit premises are open for
6 business.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	New section

Statement of Purpose:

To eliminate a regulatory requirement that beer coolers accessible to the public be locked during hours when the sale of alcoholic liquors for off-premises consumption is forbidden and grocery store beer permit premises are open for business.
