AN ACT CONCERNING MANDATED REPORTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 17a-101 of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July*
3 *1, 2008*):

4 (b) The following persons shall be mandated reporters: Any
5 physician or surgeon licensed under the provisions of chapter 370, any
6 resident physician or intern in any hospital in this state, whether or not
7 so licensed, any registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, medical
8 examiner, dentist, dental hygienist, psychologist, coach of intramural
9 or interscholastic athletics, school superintendent, school teacher,
10 school principal, school guidance counselor, school paraprofessional,
11 school coach, social worker, police officer, juvenile or adult probation
12 officer, juvenile or adult parole officer, member of the clergy,
13 pharmacist, physical therapist, optometrist, chiropractor, podiatrist,
14 mental health professional or physician assistant, any person who is a
15 licensed or certified emergency medical services provider, any person
16 who is a licensed or certified alcohol and drug counselor, any person
