AN ACT CONCERNING A GRANT TO A TAX EXEMPT ORGANIZATION WITH A MISSION TO REDUCE CULTURAL, SOCIO-ECONOMIC AND RACIAL ISOLATION IN THE EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2008*) The sum of three hundred thousand
2 dollars is appropriated to the Department of Education, from the
3 General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, for purposes of
4 providing a grant to a tax-exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3)
5 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or any subsequent
6 corresponding internal revenue code of the United States, as from time
7 to time amended, with a mission to reduce cultural, socio-economic
8 and racial isolation in the educational system and communities
9 through partnerships with school districts, interdistrict magnet
10 schools, schools of education at institutions of higher education and
11 private sector donors.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
