AN ACT CONCERNING BIODEGRADABLE PAINTBALL PROJECTILES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective January 1, 2009*) (a) No person shall use or
2 possess a paintball pellet or projectile on state or municipally-owned
3 property unless such paintball or projectile is biodegradable.
- 4 (b) Any person who violates subsection (a) of this section shall be
5 deemed to have committed an infraction.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
