AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF STATE COMPUTERS ON NONSTATE PROPERTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) Notwithstanding any
2 provision of the general statutes, no state employee shall remove from
3 his or her place of employment any state-issued computer that
4 contains personal or confidential information, as determined by the
5 agency or department that employs such employee.

6 (b) Each state agency and department shall establish a policy
7 concerning computer-based personal and confidential information.
8 Such policy shall indicate the information that such agency or
9 department deems personal or confidential in nature such that the
10 presence of such information on a state-issued computer prohibits the
11 removal of such computer from such agency or department by a state
12 employee, as described in subsection (a) of this section.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit state employees from taking state-issued computers from their place of employment if the computer contains personal and confidential information.
