"AN ACT CONCERNING A COMMISSION ON AMERICAN INDIAN AFFAIRS."

1 In line 34, strike "who are" and insert ", five of whom shall be
2 representatives of each of the following Indian tribes: The
3 Schaghticoke, the Paucatuck Eastern Pequot, the Mashantucket
4 Pequot, the Mohegan, and the Golden Hill Paugussett, six of whom
5 shall be American Indians indigenous to Connecticut and four of
6 whom shall be nonindigenous American Indians, Alaskan Natives or
7 Native Hawaiians residing in the state of Connecticut."

8 Strike line 35 in its entirety

9 In line 36, strike "and" and insert "The fifteen voting members" in
10 lieu thereof

11 In line 115, strike "the"

12 In line 116, strike "community" and insert "communities" in lieu
13 thereof

14 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
15 internal references accordingly:

16 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) All personnel and material
17 costs currently allocated to the Department of Environmental
18 Protection associated with the Council on Indian Affairs shall be
19 transferred to the Commission on American Indian Affairs, to
20 effectuate the provisions of sections 47-59b, 10-382, 10a-112, 19a-4j, 47-
21 65, 47-66, 47-66g, 47-66i and 47-66j of the general statutes, as amended
22 by this act.

23 Sec. 502. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) All funds currently
24 appropriated in fiscal year 2009 to the Office of Legislative
25 Management for the study of the creation of a Commission on Native
26 Americans shall be transferred to the Commission on American Indian
27 Affairs for operating expenses necessary to effectuate the provisions of
28 sections 47-59b, 10-382, 10a-112, 19a-4j, 47-65, 47-66, 47-66g, 47-66i and
29 47-66j of the general statutes, as amended by this act."
