"AN ACT CONCERNING THE SECURITY OF CHILDREN AT POLLING LOCATIONS."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) The principal of any school
4 may request the head of the police department of the municipality, or
5 if none, a constable serving the municipality, to provide police
6 protection at such school whenever such school will be used as a
7 polling place and the principal anticipates a potential risk to student
8 safety.

9 Sec. 2. Section 10-220 of the general statutes is amended by adding
10 subsection (e) as follows (*Effective from passage*):

11 (NEW) (e) Each local or regional board of education shall have and
12 biennially review a security plan for each school in its district at which
13 polling occurs in connection with an election. Such security plan shall
14 address the potential safety risks that such use poses to the school and

15 students who attend such school and shall include, but not be limited
16 to, parking procedures, designated ingress and egress locations,
17 emergency communications systems and security personnel protocols.
18 In the event that a local or regional school board has a security plan in
19 effect for each school as of the effective date of this section, such plan
20 shall be amended to address the potential safety risks to students from
21 the use of each such school as a polling place."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
