"AN ACT CONCERNING THE COMPENSATION OF WRONGFULLY CONVICTED AND INCARCERATED PERSONS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) Beginning with the
4 session of the General Assembly commencing on January 7, 2009, a
5 racial and ethnic impact statement shall be prepared with respect to
6 certain bills and amendments that could, if passed, increase or
7 decrease the pretrial or sentenced population of the correctional

8 facilities in this state.

9 (b) Not later than January 1, 2009, the joint standing committee of
10 the General Assembly on judiciary shall make recommendations for a
11 provision to be included in the joint rules of the House of
12 Representatives and the Senate concerning the procedure for the
13 preparation of such racial and ethnic impact statements, the content of
14 such statements and the types of bills and amendments with respect to
15 which such statements should be prepared."
