PRIVATE DETECTIVES, GUARD SERVICES AND SECURITY  
PERSONNEL."**

1 In line 195, after "officer" insert ", as defined in section 29-152u, as  
2 amended by this act,"

3 In line 209, after "commissioner" insert "and accompanied by a fee of  
4 twenty dollars"

5 In line 215, strike "said" and after "29-161x" insert ", as amended by  
6 this act,"

7 In line 221, after "suspended." insert "The term for such approval  
8 shall not exceed two years. Not later than two business days after a  
9 change of address, any person approved as an instructor in accordance  
10 with this section shall notify the commissioner of such change and  
11 such notification shall include both the old and new addresses."

12 Strike lines 222 to 226, inclusive, in their entirety, and insert the  
13 following in lieu thereof:

14        "(2) If a security officer training course described in this subsection  
15 is approved by the commissioner on or before September 30, 2008, the  
16 instructor of such course shall have until April 1, 2009, to apply for  
17 approval as an instructor in accordance with subdivision (1) of this  
18 subsection.

19        (3) Each person approved as an instructor in accordance with this  
20 section may apply for the renewal of such approval on a form  
21 approved by the commissioner, accompanied by a fee of twenty  
22 dollars. Such form may require the disclosure of any information  
23 necessary for the commissioner to determine whether the instructor's  
24 suitability to serve as an instructor has changed since the issuance of  
25 the prior approval. The term of such renewed approval shall not  
26 exceed two years."

29        After line 280, insert the following and reletter the remaining  
30 subsections accordingly:

31        "(f) Any fee or portion of a fee paid pursuant to this section shall not  
32 be refundable."

33        In line 283, strike "persons are licensed security officers" and insert  
34 in lieu thereof "person is a licensed security officer"

35        In line 285, strike "(f)" and insert "(g)" in lieu thereof

36        Strike lines 387 to 409, inclusive, in their entirety

37        In line 410, strike the opening and closing brackets and strike "(d)"

38        In line 410, bracket "such" and insert "a special" after the closing  
39 bracket

40        After line 415, insert the following:

41        "(d) (1) On and after October 1, 2008, no person or employee of an  
42 association, corporation or partnership shall conduct the training  
43 pursuant to subsection (b) of this section without the approval of the  
44 commissioner, except as provided in subdivision (2) of this subsection.  
45 Application for such approval shall be submitted on forms prescribed  
46 by the commissioner, accompanied by a fee of twenty dollars. Such  
47 application shall be made under oath and shall contain the applicant's  
48 name, address, date and place of birth, employment for the previous  
49 five years, education or training in the subjects required to be taught  
50 under subsection (b) of this section, any convictions for violations of  
51 the law and such other information as the commissioner may require  
52 by regulation adopted pursuant to section 29-161x, as amended by this  
53 act, to properly investigate the character, competency and integrity of  
54 the applicant. No person shall be approved as an instructor for such  
55 training who has been convicted of a felony, a sexual offense or a crime  
56 of moral turpitude or who has been denied approval as a security  
57 service licensee, a security officer or instructor in the security industry  
58 by any licensing authority, or whose approval has been revoked or  
59 suspended. The term for such approval shall not exceed two years. Not  
60 later than two business days after a change of address, any person  
61 approved as an instructor in accordance with this section shall notify  
62 the commissioner of such change and such notification shall include  
63 both the old and new addresses.

64        (2) If a course of training in the safety and use of firearms is  
65 approved by the commissioner in accordance with subsection (b) of  
66 this section on or before September 30, 2008, the person serving as an  
67 instructor of such course shall have until April 1, 2009, to apply for  
68 approval as an instructor in accordance with subdivision (1) of this  
69 subsection.

70        (3) Each person approved as an instructor in accordance with this  
71 section may apply for the renewal of such approval on a form  
72 approved by the commissioner, accompanied by a fee of twenty  
73 dollars. Such form may require the disclosure of any information  
74 necessary for the commissioner to determine whether the instructor's

75 suitability to serve as an instructor has changed since the issuance of  
76 the prior approval. The term of such renewed approval shall not  
77 exceed two years.

79 section shall not be refundable."
