"AN ACT CONCERNING IDENTITY THEFT."

1 Strike section 1 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

2 "Section 1. Subsection (h) of section 53a-40 of the general statutes, as
3 amended by section 7 of public act 08-1 of the January special session,
4 is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*
5 *from passage*):

6 (h) When any person has been found to be a persistent dangerous
7 felony offender, the court, in lieu of imposing the sentence of
8 imprisonment authorized by [section 53a-35 for the crime of which
9 such person presently stands convicted, or authorized by section
10 53a-35a if the crime of which such person presently stands convicted
11 was committed on or after July 1, 1981, shall] the general statutes for
12 the crime of which such person presently stands convicted, (1) shall
13 sentence such person to a term of imprisonment [of not more than

14 forty years] that is not (A) less than twice the minimum term of
15 imprisonment authorized for such crime or (B) more than twice the
16 maximum term of imprisonment authorized for such crime or forty
17 years, whichever is greater, provided, if a mandatory minimum term
18 of imprisonment is authorized for such crime, such sentence shall
19 include a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment that is twice
20 such authorized mandatory minimum term of imprisonment, and [,]
21 (2) if such person has, at separate times prior to the commission of the
22 present crime, been twice convicted of and imprisoned for any of the
23 crimes enumerated in [subparagraph (B) of subdivision (1) of]
24 subsection (a) of this section, as amended, shall sentence such person
25 to [a term of imprisonment of not more than life] life imprisonment
26 without parole."
