"AN ACT CONCERNING HOME HEATING RELIEF."

1 Strike subsection (a) of section 8 in its entirety and insert the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Sec. 8. (*Effective from passage*) (a) After all appropriations have been
4 made pursuant to this act and bill 1101 of the current session from the
5 funds credited to the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30,
6 2009, pursuant to subsection (a) of section 1 of this act, the remainder
7 of such funds shall be appropriated to the Office of Policy and
8 Management, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, provided no
9 more than \$35,000,000 shall be appropriated to the Office of Policy and
10 Management. Such funds appropriated to the Office of Policy and
11 Management shall be deposited in an energy contingency account,
12 which shall be established for such purpose. Funds in the account may
13 be used to provide emergency home heating assistance to state
14 residents, with consideration given to households with preexisting all

15 electric heating, to supplement federal funding for the Connecticut
16 energy assistance program and to provide assistance to meals on
17 wheels nutrition programs to defray the cost of gasoline. Any funds
18 remaining in the energy contingency account on June 30, 2009, shall
19 not lapse, but shall be available for expenditure during the fiscal year
20 ending June 30, 2010."
