Title: AN ACT PERMITTING THE TOWING OF CERTAIN TRUCKS AND TRAILERS BY LICENSED REPAIR TOW TRUCKS; REQUIRING THE SALE AND PURCHASE OF A MOTOR VEHICLE TO BE RECORDED WITH THE TOWN CLERK OF THE MUNICIPALITY IN WHICH THE SELLER AND PURCHASER RESIDE; PROVIDING PROTECTIONS FOR MOTOR VEHICLE OWNERS WHOSE VEHICLES ARE TOWED; AND PROTECTING THE ABILITY OF A PERSON WHOSE MOTOR VEHICLE HAS BEEN STOLEN TO RETRIEVE SUCH VEHICLE.

Statement of Purpose: (1) To permit licensed repair tow trucks to tow disabled trucks and trailers without regard to the length, width or weight of such disabled truck or trailer; (2) to require the purchase and sale of a motor vehicle to be recorded in the office of the town clerk of the municipality in which the seller and the purchaser reside; (3) to provide protections for motor vehicle owners whose vehicles are towed; and (4) to protect the ability of a crime victim whose motor vehicle has been stolen to retrieve the vehicle.
