Title: AN ACT INCREASING GRANTS TO MUNICIPALITIES FOR COLLEGES AND HOSPITALS THAT ARE EXEMPT FROM PROPERTY TAXES.

Statement of Purpose: To ensure that municipalities receive full payment of state grants in lieu of taxes for private nonprofit institutions of higher learning and nonprofit hospitals located in such municipalities by removing the provision that permits the state to proportionately reduce grants in the event that total amount of grants exceeds amounts appropriated to effectuate the provisions of this section.
