Title: AN ACT MAKING TECHNICAL REVISIONS AND MINOR CHANGES TO THE INSURANCE STATUTES.

Statement of Purpose: To make technical revisions to the insurance statutes, to establish certain requirements for health plans approved by the Comptroller and to specify that such plans are subject to the insurance statutes, and to require the Insurance Commissioner to find that any action taken to nominate, appoint or elect members to the board of directors of a domestic insurance company has the effect of changing or influencing the control of said company, for purposes of section 38a-133 of the general statutes.
