Title: AN ACT CONCERNING PUBLIC HEALTH PREPAREDNESS.

Statement of Purpose: To: (1) Permit the Department of Public Health in times of a declared public health or civil preparedness emergency to temporarily suspend license renewal and inspection functions thereby allowing the department to devote resources to the emergency while ensuring that health care worker and facility licenses do not lapse during the period of the emergency, and (2) amend the nerve agent antidote autoinjector statute to allow the delivery of nerve agent antidote autoinjector kits by emergency services personnel for treatment of the general public in an emergency response.
