"AN ACT CONCERNING THE COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT TAXES AND LOTTERY WINNINGS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the
4 deadline for the presentation to the Connecticut Lottery Corporation of
5 a winning lottery ticket to claim a prize for any Lotto lottery game, any
6 person who presents a winning Lotto lottery ticket no later than
7 seventy-two hours after the end of the time period for presenting
8 claims for any lottery game expiring on or after July 1, 1996, may file a
9 claim for such prize until August 1, 2008. Such claim shall be
10 accompanied by a filing fee of one hundred fifty dollars. Upon such
11 application, said corporation shall award such prize out of unclaimed

12 prize funds as follows: (1) Ten per cent of such prize shall be paid to
13 the Division of Special Revenue, which shall deposit such funds into
14 the chronic gamblers treatment and rehabilitation account created
15 pursuant to section 17a-713 of the general statutes, and (2) ninety per
16 cent of such prize shall be paid to the claimant. If the value of the prize
17 exceeds one million dollars, the claimant shall receive an initial
18 payment of one million dollars at the time of filing a claim, followed
19 by annual payments of no more than one million dollars on each
20 succeeding July first, until such ninety per cent amount is paid."
