**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE DESIGNATION OF ALL-TERRAIN
VEHICLE TRAILS, A TRAIL USER FEE AND ALL-TERRAIN
VEHICLE REGISTRATION."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2008*) (a) No person sixteen years
4 of age or under may operate an all-terrain vehicle on state property
5 unless such person is (1) under direct adult supervision, and (2)
6 wearing protective headgear which conforms to the minimum
7 specifications established by the Snell Memorial Foundation's
8 Standard for Protective Headgear for Use in All-Terrain Vehicle
9 Riding.

10 (b) If any person operates an all-terrain vehicle in violation of
11 subsection (a) of this section, a law enforcement officer may issue a
12 verbal warning to such operator or, if such operator is a minor, to the

13 parent or guardian of such operator."
