**"AN ACT CONCERNING AUTHORITY OF BOARDS OF
SELECTMEN AND THE VALUE OF PROPERTY NECESSARY FOR
ELIGIBILITY TO VOTE."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2008*) (a) The Auditors of Public
4 Accounts, within available appropriations, shall audit the books and
5 accounts of any municipality that receives state funding in an amount
6 that is more than thirty-three per cent of the annual operating budget
7 of such municipality. Each such audit of a municipality shall include
8 any recommendations for management efficiencies and financial
9 improvements.

10 (b) The auditors shall issue a request for proposals for independent
11 auditors to conduct the audits required under subsection (a) of this
12 section. As used in this subsection, "independent auditor" means a
13 public accountant who is licensed to practice in the state and meets the
14 independence standards included in generally accepted government
15 auditing standards."
