"AN ACT CONCERNING THE SEXUAL ASSAULT OF CHILDREN."

1 Strike section 508 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "Sec. 508. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2008*) (a) Any person who has
4 reason to believe that a person required to register under the
5 provisions of section 502, 503 or 504 of this act or section 54-253 or 54-
6 254 of the 2008 supplement to the general statutes, as amended by this
7 act, is in violation of registration requirements and who, with intent to
8 assist the registrant in eluding a law enforcement officer enforcing
9 such registration requirements, checking on the registrant's compliance
10 with such registration requirements or investigating a violation of such
11 registration requirements, (1) withholds information from, or does not
12 notify, the law enforcement officer about the registrant's
13 noncompliance with the requirements of said sections and, if known,
14 the whereabouts of the registrant, (2) harbors, or attempts to harbor, or

15 assists another person in harboring or attempting to harbor, the
16 registrant, (3) conceals or attempts to conceal, or assists another person
17 in concealing or attempting to conceal, the registrant, (4) knowingly
18 provides false information regarding the registrant, (5) obstructs or
19 hinders the law enforcement officer in the performance of such
20 officer's official duties relative to such enforcement, compliance check
21 or investigation, or (6) falsely represents the registrant by signing
22 address verification forms or other official documentation relative to
23 the registration of sexual offenders, shall be guilty of a class D felony.

24 (b) Any person who (1) is employed at, staffs or is otherwise
25 authorized to work at a homeless, emergency or other shelter, (2) has
26 reason to believe that a person who is required to register under the
27 provisions of section 502, 503 or 504 of this act or section 54-253 or 54-
28 254 of the 2008 supplement to the general statutes, as amended by this
29 act, has listed such shelter as his or her residence address and is in
30 violation of registration requirements, and (3) (A) withholds
31 information about the whereabouts, if known, of the registrant from a
32 law enforcement officer who is enforcing the registration
33 requirements, checking on the registrant's compliance with such
34 requirements or investigating a violation of such requirements, (B)
35 knowingly provides false information to a law enforcement officer
36 regarding the registrant, or (C) obstructs or hinders a law enforcement
37 officer in the performance of such officer's official duties relative to
38 such enforcement, compliance check or investigation, shall be guilty of
39 a class D felony."
