"AN ACT CONCERNING THE BEST PROGRAM."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of
4 subdivision (26) of section 10-183b of the 2008 supplement to the
5 general statutes concerning the requirement that a teacher hold a
6 certificate for the position in which he is employed, any teacher who
7 was previously certified by the State of New York in elementary
8 education and secondary English and was issued by the Connecticut
9 State Board of Education a nonrenewable, interim certificate with
10 effective dates of July 1, 1993, through August 31, 1994, for elementary
11 education and secondary English and who possessed only a valid
12 elementary education certificate from July 1, 1994, through December
13 1, 2003, and was notified that he is not properly certified for the
14 position in which he is employed or has been employed, such teacher
15 shall receive no further credit in the teachers' retirement system for
16 employment in such position until the teacher becomes properly

17 certified for such position. The Teachers' Retirement Board shall not
18 rescind any credited service to such teacher employed between the
19 dates of July 1, 1993, and December 1, 2003, and shall restore any such
20 credit to such teacher if rescinded prior to the effective date of this
21 section."
