**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONTROL OF LYME DISEASE."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 14-380 of the general statutes is repealed and the  
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective January 1, 2010*):

5 On or after October 1, 1971, no person shall operate and no owner  
6 shall permit the operation of any snowmobile or all-terrain vehicle  
7 unless the owner holds a valid, effective registration awarded by this  
8 state or by another state or by the United States, provided such state or  
9 district of registration grants substantially similar privileges for  
10 snowmobiles or all-terrain vehicles owned by residents of this state  
11 and registered under its laws, and unless the identification number set  
12 forth in such registration is displayed on such snowmobile or all-

13 terrain vehicle as prescribed in section 14-381, provided every resident  
14 of this state shall obtain such registration from this state under the  
15 provisions of section 14-381, before such operation shall be lawful. The  
16 provisions of this section shall not apply (1) to the operation of a  
17 snowmobile [or all-terrain vehicle] on premises owned or leased by the  
18 owner of such snowmobile, [or all-terrain vehicle] or (2) to the  
19 operation of a snowmobile in any organized contest as long as such  
20 snowmobile is operated in the contest area, provided the owner of  
21 such snowmobile holds a valid, effective registration awarded by this  
22 state or by another state or the United States."
