"AN ACT CONCERNING ENERGY ASSISTANCE."

1 Strike subsection (a) of section 16 in its entirety and insert the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Sec. 16. (*Effective from passage*) (a) After appropriations have been
4 made pursuant to sections 6 to 13, inclusive, and 15 to 19, inclusive, of
5 this act from the funds credited to the General Fund for the fiscal year
6 ending June 30, 2009, pursuant to subsection (a) of section 1 of this act,
7 the remainder of such funds shall be appropriated to the Office of
8 Policy and Management, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009,
9 provided no more than \$35,000,000 shall be appropriated to the Office
10 of Policy and Management. Such funds appropriated to the Office of
11 Policy and Management shall be deposited in an energy contingency
12 account, which shall be established for such purpose. Funds in the
13 account may be used to provide emergency home heating assistance to
14 state residents, with consideration given to households with

15 preexisting all electric heating, to supplement federal funding for the
16 Connecticut energy assistance program and to provide assistance to
17 meals on wheels nutrition programs to defray the cost of gasoline. Any
18 funds remaining in the energy contingency account on June 30, 2009,
19 shall not lapse, but shall be available for expenditure during the fiscal
20 year ending June 30, 2010."
