Official Address and Service of Legal Process

Sections 14 –137-18 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

- (a) All communications should be addressed to the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, [60 State Street, Wethersfield, Connecticut 06109] Rowland State Government Center, 55 West Main Street, Waterbury, Connecticut 06702-2004, unless otherwise specifically indicated.
- (b) If the service of an administrative appeal of a final decision of the Commissioner is made by mail, as authorized by the provisions of section 4-183 of Connecticut General Statutes, the envelope shall be addressed to the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, Rowland State Government Center, 55 West Main Street, Waterbury, Connecticut 06702-2004.
- (c) Except as provided in subsection (d) of this section, all service of legal process on the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, the Department of Motor Vehicles or any official or employee of the Department acting in such person's official capacity, shall be served, unless otherwise provided by statute or order of any court, at the office of the Commissioner, Rowland State Government Center, 55 West Main Street, Waterbury, Connecticut 06702-2004.
- (d) Service of legal process upon a non-resident or a motor vehicle operator or owner not found at such person's recorded address, in accordance with the provisions of sections 52-62 and 52-63 of the Connecticut General Statutes may be made at the Branch Office at the Department of Motor Vehicles located at 60 State Street, Wethersfield, Connecticut 06109. The officer serving the process may be required to execute a form, as prescribed by the Commissioner that records the day and hour of service.

Statement of Purpose:

Purpose: To update the official address of the Commissioner of the Department of Motor Vehicles and to delineate the location for service of legal process on said Commissioner and Department.

Summary of Main Provisions:

The official address of the Commissioner of Motor Vehicle is 55 West Main Street, Waterbury, Connecticut 06702-2004.

Administrative Appeals filed pursuant to section 4-183 of the Connecticut General Statutes shall be mailed to that address.

Service of legal process on the Commissioner or Department shall be at this address, unless otherwise provided by statute or court order.
