



Substitute Senate Bill No. 1021

Public Act No. 09-30

AN ACT CONCERNING NOTIFICATION OF CONTAMINANTS IN DRINKING WATER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Not later than five business days after receiving notice that a public water system is in violation of the federal Environmental Protection Agency national primary drinking water standards, the Commissioner of Public Health shall give written or electronic notification of such violation to the chief elected official of the municipality where such public water system is located and of any municipality that is served by such public water system.
