



Substitute House Bill No. 5108

Public Act No. 09-180

AN ACT PRESERVING CERTAIN HORSE TRAILS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Commissioner of Environmental Protection shall preserve the following trails for equine use: (1) Larkin State Park trails (Southbury-Oxford-Middlebury); (2) Airline State Park trails - south and north (Colchester-Hebron-Lebanon-Windham-Hampton-Pomfret-Putnam); (3) Hop River State Park trails (Bolton-Coventry-Andover-Columbia); (4) Moosup Valley State Park trails (Sterling-Plainfield); (5) Huntington State Park trails; (6) Natchaug State Forest trails; and (7) Cockaponset State Forest trails.

(b) Nothing in this section shall prohibit nonequine uses by the public of the trails specified in subsection (a) of this section.

(c) The preservation of a trail by the Commissioner of Environmental Protection pursuant to subsection (a) of this section shall not be deemed an expansion of such trail.
