Substitute House Bill No. 5834

House of Representatives, March 24, 2009

The Committee on Higher Education and Employment Advancement reported through REP. WILLIS of the 64th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the substitute bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF THE HIGHEST AND BEST UNIVERSITY USE FOR THE UCONN STAMFORD CAMPUS PARKING GARAGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The University of Connecticut shall
2 study and make recommendations for the highest and best use for the
3 university land upon which the parking garage at the university's
4 Stamford campus is located. The university's chief operating officer
5 shall appoint an advisory committee not to exceed seven members to
6 assist the university in developing its recommendations. The advisory
7 committee shall be comprised of volunteers from the community and
8 university personnel, including the chief administrator of the
9 university's Stamford campus. The university shall submit its
10 recommendations not later than May 1, 2010, to the joint standing
11 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
12 relating to higher education, in accordance with section 11-4a of the
13 general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
