House Bill No. 5841

*House of Representatives, April 2, 2009*

The Committee on Human Services reported through REP. WALKER of the 93rd Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the bill ought to pass.

***AN ACT CONCERNING A UNIFORM REPORTING FORM FOR PRESCHOOL AND CHILD CARE PROGRAMS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) Not later than January 1, 2010, the  
2 Commissioner of Social Services, in collaboration with the  
3 Commissioners of Education and Public Health, shall develop, and  
4 implement the use of, a single form for providers of preschool and  
5 child care services to report information necessary to receive state  
6 funding.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
