Resolved by this Assembly:

- 1 That the decision of the Claims Commissioner, file number 21052 of
- 2 said commissioner, ordering the dismissal of the claim against the state
- 3 in excess of seven thousand five hundred dollars of Sabia & Hartley,
- 4 LLC, is vacated and payment to the claimant in the amount of twenty-
- 5 one thousand three hundred thirty-eight dollars and two cents is
- 6 ordered.
