The Committee on Energy and Technology reported through SEN. FONFARA, J. of the 1st Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING TELECOMMUNICATIONS PROVIDERS' SUBSCRIBER LISTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2009*) (a) A certified
2 telecommunications provider, as defined in section 16-1 of the general
3 statutes, or any company, except commercial mobile radio service
4 providers, using telephone numbers from the North American
5 Number Planning Administration shall arrange for the publication of
6 such provider's or company's subscriber list information in a local
7 telephone directory. Such provider or company shall not publish such
8 subscriber list information for any subscriber who has specifically
9 requested such information not be published.

10 (b) Such provider or subscriber shall furnish its subscriber list
11 information (1) on a nondiscriminatory basis to any requesting
12 directory publisher at a price not to exceed levels established by the
13 Federal Communications Commission, (2) as base file extracts and files
14 of listing updates, and (3) no less frequently than once a month.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Explanation

This bill places requirements on certified telecommunications providers to arrange for publication of their subscriber list information in a local telephone directory. There is no anticipated fiscal impact on this bill.

OLR Bill Analysis**SB 600*****AN ACT CONCERNING TELECOMMUNICATIONS PROVIDERS' SUBSCRIBER LISTS.*****SUMMARY:**

This bill requires certified telecommunications providers (companies other than telephone companies that provide telecommunications services) and any company, except wireless service providers, that uses telephone numbers from the North American Number Planning Administration to arrange for the publication of its subscriber list information in a local telephone directory. The provider or company may not publish this information for any subscriber who has specifically requested that it not be published.

The provider or subscriber (apparently company) must furnish its subscriber list information (1) on a nondiscriminatory basis to any requesting directory publisher at no more than the price set by the Federal Communications Commission and (2) as base file extracts and files of listing updates. They must do so at least once per month.
