The Committee on Higher Education and Employment Advancement reported through SEN. HANDLEY of the 4th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the substitute bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONNECTICUT STUDENT LOAN FOUNDATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective October 1, 2009*) The Department of Higher
2 Education shall submit a report, in accordance with section 11-4a of the
3 general statutes, regarding its recommendations concerning the
4 Connecticut Student Loan Foundation to the joint standing committee
5 of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to
6 higher education not later than January 1, 2010.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
