Senate Bill No. 1081

*Senate, March 31, 2009*

The Committee on Transportation reported through SEN. DEFRONZO of the 6th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the bill ought to pass.

## **AN ACT CONCERNING THE FUNCTIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2009*) The Commissioner of  
2 Motor Vehicles shall review the programs and functions of the  
3 Department of Motor Vehicles in order to evaluate such programs and  
4 functions, and develop recommendations concerning funding, transfer  
5 to a state or private entity, changes to, or repeal of such programs and  
6 functions. The commissioner shall submit such recommendations, in  
7 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,  
8 to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having  
9 cognizance of matters relating to motor vehicles not later than January  
10 1, 2010, and annually thereafter.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	<i>October 1, 2009</i>	New section

***AN ACT CONCERNING THE FUNCTIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES.***

**SUMMARY:**

This bill requires the motor vehicle commissioner to review and evaluate his department's programs and functions and develop recommendations for changing or repealing them, funding them, or transferring them to a state or private entity. The commissioner must submit any recommendations to the Transportation Committee annually, beginning January 1, 2010.
