I worked as a driver for 1 ½ years at TCI Trucking in South Windsor, CT. I fell off of a truck on 4/10/08. I shattered my elbow. I went to the hospital and had three surgeries. I was in the hospital for five days. I went home and I was supposed to go to a convalescent home. A friend drove me there, but they wouldn't accept me because the worker's comp insurance didn't go through. So I had to go back home.

My neighbors had to help me because I couldn't take care of myself. I should have been in the convalescent home. I couldn't take care of myself and I got infections. I had to keep going to the hospital. But the insurance didn't go through.

I'm still having problems getting worker's comp so they'll pay the medical bills. They asked me for my log book, and I told them that I gave it to the company. Worker's comp hasn't decided how to solve this. In the meantime, I'm getting bills for the ambulance, doctors, therapy and prescriptions. This is hurting me more because they're dragging it out. It hurts my credit. I got a couple of letters from collection agencies.

I'm telling you this to help other people.

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
