**AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF PRESCRIPTION DRUG HISTORY
AS AN UNDERWRITING TOOL TO DENY HEALTH INSURANCE
COVERAGE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to prohibit the use
- 2 of an individual's prescription drug history as a criteria for
- 3 underwriting to deny such individual health insurance coverage if
- 4 there is no definitive diagnosis.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit the use of an individual's prescription drug history as a criteria for underwriting to deny such individual health insurance coverage if there is no definitive diagnosis.
