AN ACT REQUIRING WRITTEN DISCLOSURE OF AN INCREASE IN HOMEOWNERS INSURANCE POLICY PREMIUMS DUE TO A CLAIM PENALTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to require insurers,
- 2 if increasing a homeowners insurance policy premium because of a
- 3 claim submitted, to provide written disclosure to such homeowner
- 4 during the renewal process of the specific amount of the increase
- 5 attributable to the claim, the duration such increase shall be in effect
- 6 and the date the increase shall be removed.

Statement of Purpose:

To require insurers, if increasing a homeowners insurance policy premium because of a claim submitted, to provide written disclosure to such homeowner during the renewal process of the specific amount of the increase attributable to the claim, the duration such increase shall be in effect and the date the increase shall be removed.
