AN ACT REQUIRING A FEASIBILITY STUDY OF ACCOMMODATIONS FOR MODES OF TRANSPORTATION, OTHER THAN MOTOR VEHICLES, AT RAILROAD AND OTHER MASS TRANSIT STATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the Commissioner of Transportation shall study the feasibility
- 2 of providing suitable accommodations for modes of transportation,
- 3 other than motor vehicles, at railroad and other mass transit stations
- 4 and shall report findings and recommendations to the joint standing
- 5 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
- 6 relating to transportation in accordance with section 11-4a of the
- 7 general statutes, not later than February 3, 2010.

Statement of Purpose:

To encourage the use of bicycles, motorized scooters and similar forms of transportation, other than motor vehicles, for travel to and from mass transit stations.
