AN ACT CONCERNING THE COORDINATION OF VACATION SCHEDULES FOR TOWNS PARTICIPATING IN EACH INTERDISTRICT MAGNET SCHOOL PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 164 of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 regional educational service centers to work with towns in a region
- 3 that send students to interdistrict magnet schools on a part-time basis
- 4 to coordinate vacation schedules.

Statement of Purpose:

To enable kids attending part-time magnet school programs and part-time local schools to have a true vacation, rather than having their two programs on different schedules.
