**AN ACT CONCERNING A TUITION CAP FOR LOCAL AND REGIONAL
BOARDS OF EDUCATION WITH STUDENTS ATTENDING
INTERDISTRICT MAGNET SCHOOLS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-264l of the general statutes be amended to place a
- 2 cap on the tuition charged to a local or regional board of education by
- 3 a regional educational service center operating an interdistrict magnet
- 4 school. Such cap shall be equal to, but not greater than, the per pupil
- 5 amount the respective town is receiving under the education cost
- 6 sharing grant.

Statement of Purpose:

To control the loss of local state education dollars and increased local costs resulting from the open choice program and magnet school mandates.
