AN ACT CONCERNING A SINGLE POINT OF ENTRY FOR LONG-TERM CARE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of
- 2 Social Services to establish a state-wide single point of entry system for
- 3 individuals seeking long-term care. It is proposed that the department
- 4 (1) establish single point of entry agencies in designated geographic
- 5 service areas; and (2) develop comprehensive information on the single
- 6 point of entry system and make such information available to the
- 7 public on the long-term care web site, as provided in section 17b-367 of
- 8 the general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish a single point of entry system for individuals seeking long-term care.
