**AN ACT CONCERNING LODGING FOR PATRONS WITH ALLERGIES  
OR ASTHMA.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to create incentives for the
- 2 construction or conversion of ten per cent or greater of the rooms of a
- 3 hotel or other lodging establishment to a design that will eradicate
- 4 ninety-eight per cent or greater of indoor allergens, including the
- 5 installation of wood or tile floors, air conditioning with HEPA filters,
- 6 and the use of allergen-proof bedding.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To encourage hotels to provide rooms that are designed to minimize indoor allergens for patrons with asthma or allergies.
