AN ACT CONCERNING MAIL-IN VOTER REGISTRATION AND UNIVERSITY INTRODUCTORY PACKETS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2009*) Notwithstanding any
2 provision of the general statutes, each constituent unit of higher
3 education and each private college or university in the state shall
4 include a mail voter registration application form, as described in
5 sections 9-23l and 9-23m of the general statutes, in each enrollment
6 packet that such constituent unit, college or university sends to a
7 student that is eligible to enroll at such constituent unit, college or
8 university.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
