AN ACT CONCERNING FINGERPRINT COLLECTION BY MUNICIPAL AND STATE POLICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit any municipal
- 2 police station or state police station from refusing to collect the
- 3 fingerprints of a person requesting such fingerprinting for the
- 4 purposes of a criminal history records check in accordance with section
- 5 29-17a of the general statutes or other noncriminal purpose based upon
- 6 such person's residence in another municipality.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit police departments from refusing to fingerprint a person based upon such person's residence.
