**AN ACT CONCERNING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE ATLANTIC STATES MARINE FISHERIES COMMISSION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 26-297 of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 legislators serving on the Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commission
- 3 be members of the joint standing committee of the General Assembly
- 4 having cognizance of matters relating to the environment and not be
- 5 required to be members of the Commission on Intergovernmental
- 6 Cooperation of the state.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To require legislators serving on the Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commission to be members of the environment committee and to not require such committee members to be members of the Commission on Intergovernmental Cooperation of the state.
