**AN ACT CONCERNING HAULER ACCESS TO PETROLEUM
TERMINALS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 To amend the general statutes to prohibit a petroleum terminal from
- 2 denying access at any time to a duly licensed and insured hauler who
- 3 meets the terminal's hauler requirements.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect consumers by allowing petroleum haulers to purchase the lowest priced petroleum available at terminals.
