AN ACT CONCERNING HEALTH INSURANCE POLICY REBATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to require an
- 2 insurer, health care center, hospital and medical service corporation or
- 3 other entity that delivers, issues for delivery, renews, amends or
- 4 continues in this state any health insurance policy to offer a rebate or
- 5 incentive that is in compliance with the Health Insurance Portability
- 6 Accountability Act of 1996, P.L. 104-191, to individuals who maintain a
- 7 healthy body mass index at the time of renewal of such policy.

Statement of Purpose:

To promote wellness regimens by providing incentives to individuals who maintain a healthy body mass index.
