**AN ACT CONCERNING EMPLOYEE NOTICE OF THE AVAILABILITY
OF FEDERAL EARNED INCOME TAX CREDITS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 31 of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 employers to post a notice of the availability of federal earned income
- 3 tax credits in the same area that other required employee notices are
- 4 posted.

Statement of Purpose:

To increase use of the under-utilized federal earned income tax credit and bring an estimated sixteen million dollars in federal funds to the state's communities.
